### **VOTING ITEMS**

1. Vote to postpone the regularly scheduled City Council meeting to another date in January.

Councilmember Penn made a motion to postpone the January Regular Meeting to January 30, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. at the Community Center. Councilmember Bogenrieder seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

2. Vote to amend meeting schedule for 2024.
