Council & Committee Meeting Schedule


The Work session meeting is Thursday , June 4 at 6:30 PM. Council meeting is Tuesday, June 16 at 7:00 PM.

The City of Statham is asking all customers to pay their water bills in full by June 20, 2020. To avoid disconnection and an administration fee of \$50.00.

The Statham Police Dept. is now a proud partner with Adventure Bags Inc. Adventure Bags is a non-profit organization that provides security and comfort for displaced children. Adventure Bags distributes stuffed backpacks that are age and gender appropriate with comfort items and basic necessities. Please check them out at www.adventurebags.org.

For the month of May and June, we will be collecting coloring books and crayons or black journals and pens (for the teens and tweens). Beginning May 1st, 2020, The Statham Police Dept will be able to provide criminal history background checks for citizens requesting them.

Here are some things to remember about criminal history background checks:

\*All person requesting a criminal history background check of themselves will be required to sign a consent form, authorizing the Statham Police Dept. to obtain the information.

\*You will be required to show your driver's license (or other Govt. issued ID) at the time of the request. A copy of ID will be made an attached to consent form for audit purposes.

\*You may not obtain a criminal history about any person other than yourself. \*There will be a \$15.00 charge for all criminal history background checks. (cash or credit card only)

\*This does NOT include Driver's History, Driver's History call be obtained at the DDS or <u>www.dds.georgia.gov</u>

\*\*WATER BILL\*\*

DATES TO REMEMBER Your water bill is due on the 15th of each month, on the 16th there will be a 10% late fee added. If your bill is not paid in full on or by the 20th, you will be subject to disconnection on the 21st.

\*\*WATER METERS\*\* Please be aware that water meters have antennas. Please mow cautiously around the meters to avoid damage. Damage to the meters will result in a charge of \$185 or greater.

\*\*LIMB PICK-UP\*\* This service is available for branches under 4 inches in diameter and 4 feet long. Your pile needs to be no higher than 3 feet by 4 feet . Please place at the edge of the road, away from power lines and call City Hall to request a pick up, 770-725-5455. We will be glad to quote you a price on larger jobs, just give us a call.
