WATER BILL

DATES TO REMEMBER Water bills are due by the 15th of each month.



After this date, a 10% late fee will be automatically assessed. If your bill is not paid in-full on or by the 20th, you will be subject to disconnection on the 21st.

WATER METERS Please be aware that water meters have antennas. Mow cautiously around the meters to avoid damage. <u>Damage to the meters will result in a charge of \$185 or greater.</u>

LIMB PICKUP

LIMB PICK-UP This service is available for branches under 4 inches in diameter and 4 feet in



length. Piles need to be no higher than 3 feet x 4 feet, and placed at the edge of the road away from power lines. Call City Hall to request pickup (770) 725-5455. Staff will provide quotes for larger limb pickup requests.
